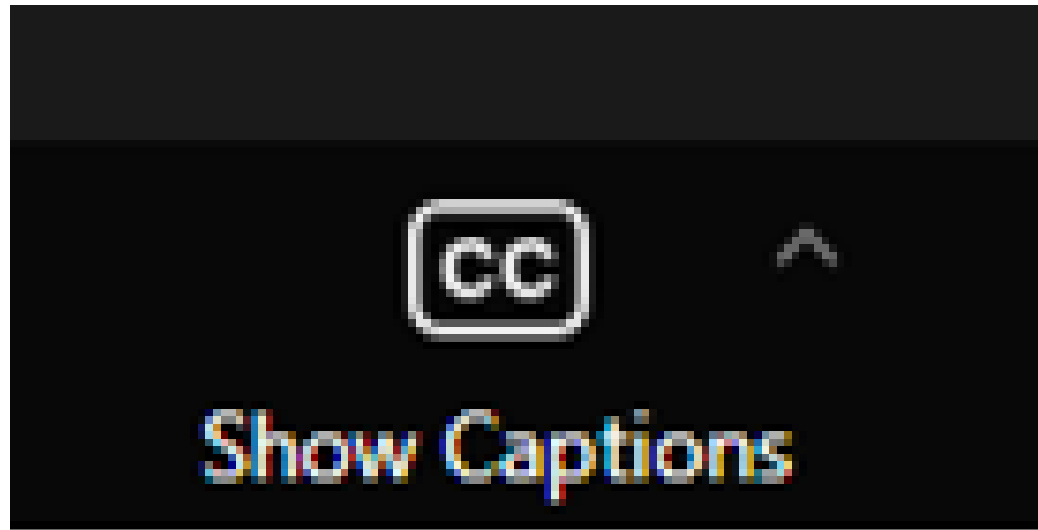

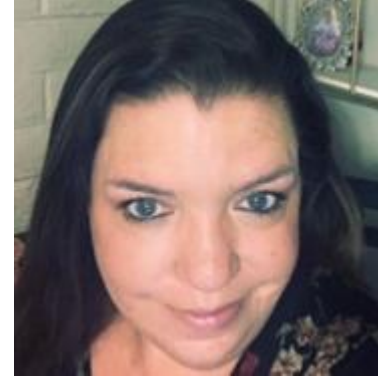

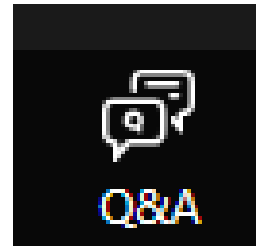

I-10 Wild Horse Pass Corridor Overview

I-10 Wild Horse Pass Corridor Overview

- 26 miles of I-10 between Loop 202 (Santan/South Mountain Freeway) to South of SR 387
- Widen I-10 by two lanes in each direction from Loop 202 to Riggs Road (one HOV lane and one general purpose lane)
- Widen I-10 by one lane in each direction from Riggs Road to South of SR 387
- Modernize five existing traffic interchanges
- Construct two new traffic interchanges (Koli Road and Seed Farm Road)
- Modernize three existing bridges over I-10
- Replace the existing bridges over the Gila River
- Install wrong way driver detection, CCTV cameras, overhead message boards, median barrier protection, and other safety features



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I-10 Wild Horse Pass Corridor Improvement Benefits

- Improve travel time reliability to and from Phoenix and communities to the south
- Improve bridges over I-10 to provide better connectivity for the Gila River Indian Community members
- Provide a wider, more resilient crossing of the Gila River
- Improve safety and operational concerns throughout the corridor
- Increase regional connectivity by providing a consistent, six-lane interstate from Phoenix to Tucson

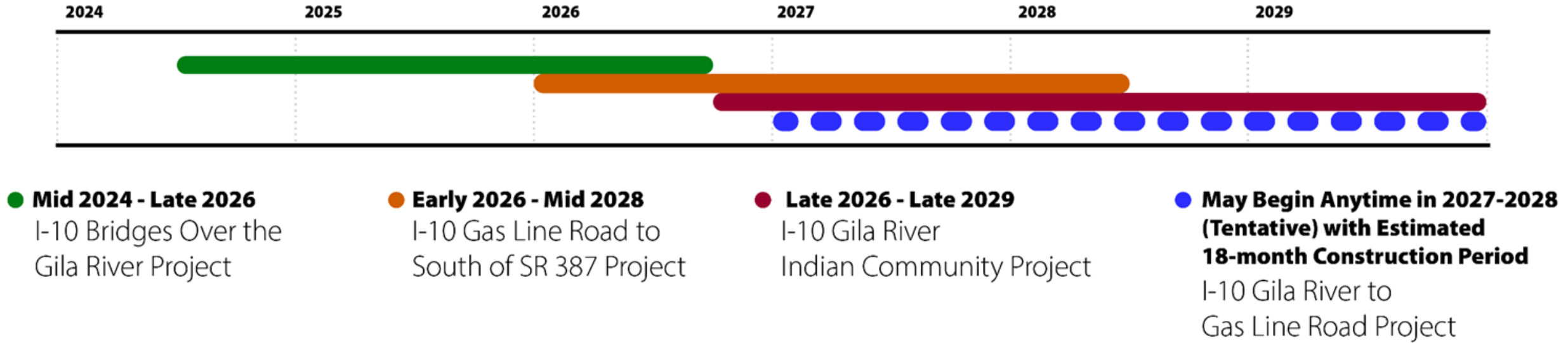


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I-10 Corridor Improvements Construction Timeline *

I-10 Corridor Construction Impact



Construction impacts will be minimized to the greatest extent possible throughout the duration of the project. There are no scheduled long-term closures.

Travelers may experience the following during construction:

- Narrowed lanes and shoulders
- Short-term closures or restrictions of I-10 ramps or crossroads
- Construction dust and noise
- Delays and overnight lane restrictions

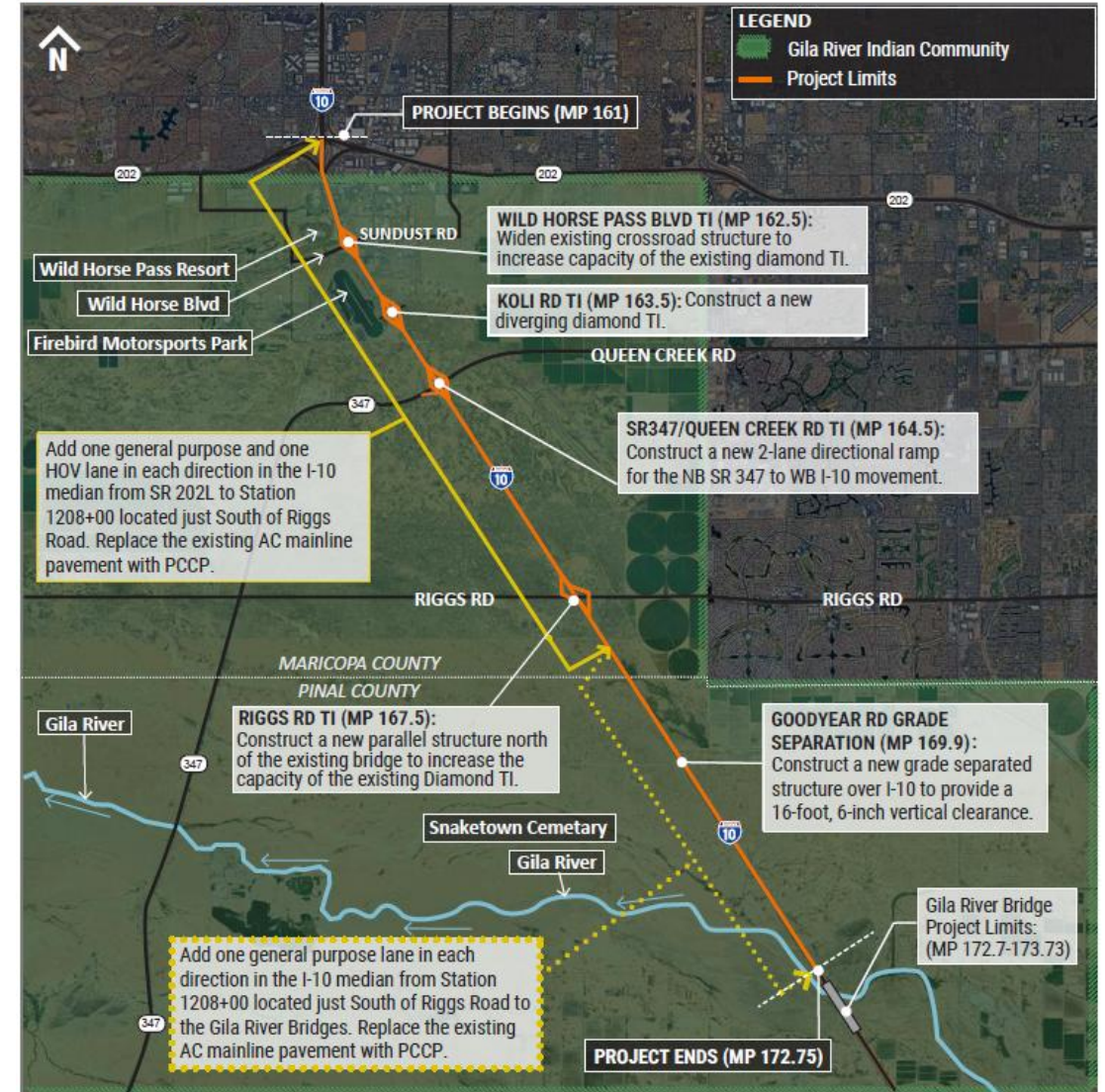

Project Description

- I-10 from State Route Loop 202 (Santan/South Mountain Freeway) to the Gila River Bridges (12-miles)
- Construct a general purpose lane and one high-occupancy (HOV) Lane in each direction in the I-10 Median from Loop 202 to just South of Riggs Road (7-miles)
- Construction of one General Purpose Lane in each direction in the median from just South of Riggs Road to the Gila River Bridges (5-miles)
- Widen or construct new bridge structures (6)
 - Widening Wild Horse Pass Boulevard Interchange Structure
 - Construct a New Koli Road Interchange
 - Construct a New NB SR 347 to WB I-10 Flyover Structure
 - Install new Queen Creek Road Bridge Barriers with Sidewalks
 - Construct a New Riggs Road Structure
 - Construct a New Goodyear Road Grade Separated Structure
- Other Project Components
 - Drainage Improvements
 - Installation of Intelligent Transportation Systems
 - Installation of Mainline Lighting to just south of Riggs
 - New Signing, Striping, and Signals
 - Installation of Bridge & Wall Aesthetic Enhancements

I-10: SR 202L to Gila River Bridges FEATURES MAP



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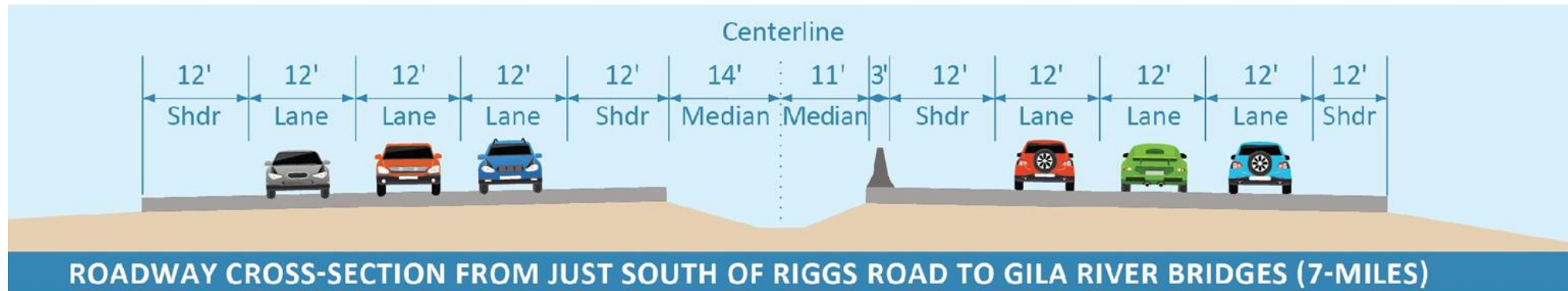


Project Innovations

- Replacement of existing Asphaltic Concrete Pavement with Portland Cement Concrete Pavement which doubles the pavement life cycle period before rehabilitation is required from 15-years to 30-years
- Construction of the NB SR 347 to WB I-10 Directional Flyover Ramp which provides a free-flowing movement that will bypass the Queen Creek Road interchange signalization

To further illustrate the new roadway sections being constructed we have developed two graphs to aid in visualizing the I-10 improvements which are discussed in more detail below.





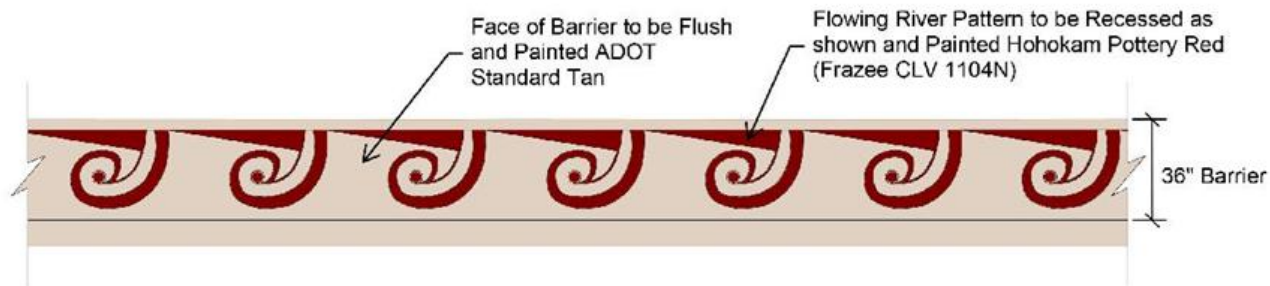
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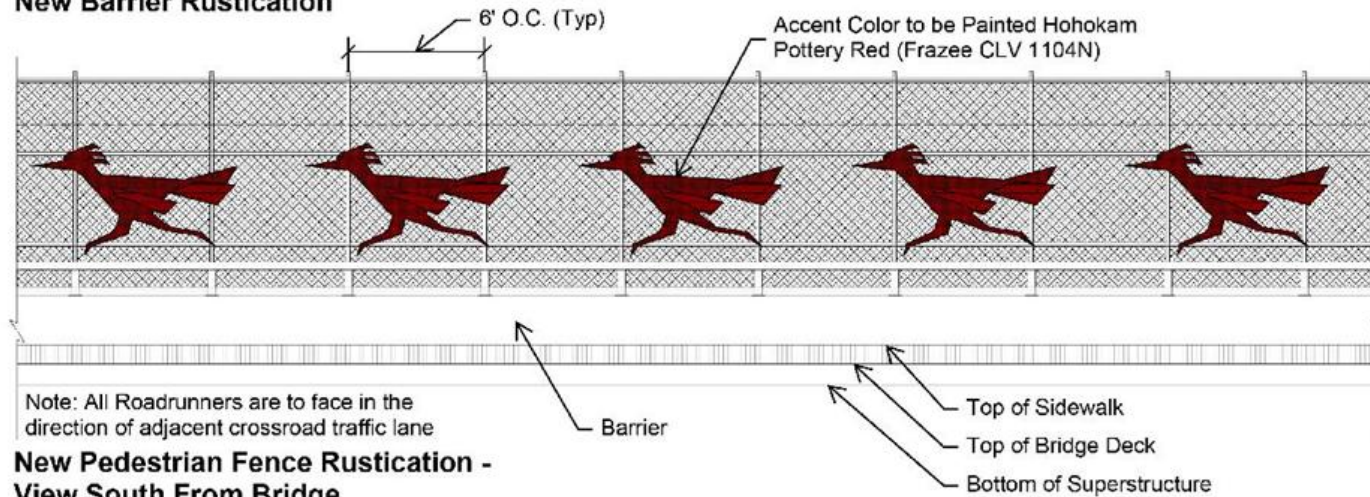


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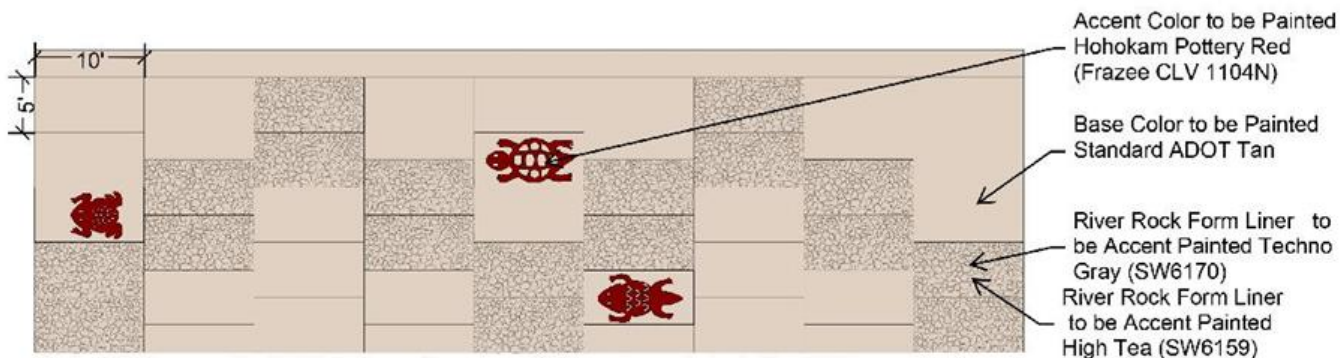
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New Barrier Rustication



New Pedestrian Fence Rustication - View South From Bridge

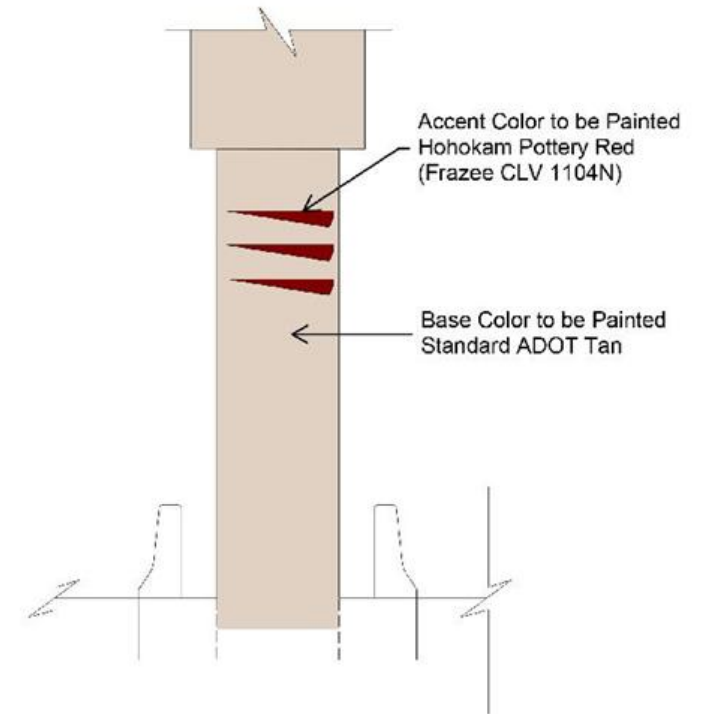


New MSE Wingwall and CIP Abutment Rustication
